

Bob Hilbert Sportswear Short Track Super Series Fueled By Sunoco Sportsman Rules & Procedures

The Bob Hilbert Sportswear Short Track Super Series Fueled By Sunoco has a three-pronged Sportsman program for the 2018 season. Each series is comprised of five events: Crate 602 North, Crate 602 South & Open Sportsman.

- All three series champions will receive \$1,000 at year-end. Drivers with perfect attendance – running all five races in their region – will be eligible for point fund money should they finish inside the top-10 in the year-end standings.
- All races will feature a draw for heat-race starting positions with a redraw of top qualifiers for the feature. After the first race of the season, there will be two series provisionals offered to the highest two drivers in the standings unable to qualify (half green money). The highest-driver in the host track points is also eligible for a provisional (relinquish green money).
- Standard bodies (see Short Track Super Series Modified rules and procedures). No sail panels with one exception: the June 5 Open event at Big Diamond.
- All events are a minimum of \$1,000 to win and \$100 to start. Heat races and consolations 8 laps. Features 25-lap minimum.
- Single-file at halfway in heats, consolations and features. Lapped cars drop to the rear in the order they are running.
- No drop races. All five races in each series count toward the final point standings.
- Standard events operate on a 100-point breakdown. Championship Points are based on a 150-point system.
- One-way radios are required at all events. Frequency: 454.000.
- Transponders are required at all events unless otherwise noted.
- All payouts will be available on race night. Please make an effort to pick up your pay.
- Gasoline only. Sunoco is the preferred fuel of the Short Track Super Series.
- Per-event entry fee: \$15 in advance or \$20 the night of event. A full-season membership covering all five events is available for \$75 per series prior to March 1.
- Drivers with extensive Modified racing experience should contact series officials for permission to participate prior to competing in any Sportsman event.
- ***Series reserves the right to adjust rules and procedures at any time during the season.***

Crate 602 Sportsman South *(open only to unaltered GM Crate 602 engines)*

Schedule: Georgetown March 17 – Bridgeport April 29 – Delaware International May 24 – Georgetown August 28 – Georgetown October 27 (Championship Points)

Tires: Fronts – American Racer 33 or harder; Left Rear – American Racer 44 or harder; Right-Rear – American Racer 48 or harder *(any track or series stamp)*

Weight: 2,350 lbs. *(post-race, with driver, track scale pounds)*

Chip: 6,200

Crate 602 Sportsman North *(open only to unaltered GM Crate 602 engines)*

Schedule: Thunder Mountain May 27 – Afton July 25 – Woodhull August 8 – Thunder Mountain September 2 – Afton October 6 (Championship Points)

Tires: Fronts – American Racer 33 or harder; Left Rear – American Racer 33 or harder; Right-Rear – American Racer 38 or harder *(any track or series stamp)*

Weight: 2,400 lbs. *(post-race, with driver, track scale pounds)*

No rev chip or gear rule.

Open Sportsman

Schedule: Big Diamond June 5 – Accord July 3 – Thunder Mountain September 15 – Bethel September 30 (60 points for all participants) – Afton October 5 (Championship Points)

Tires: Fronts – American Racer 33 or harder (all events); Left-Rear – American Racer 33 or harder (Thunder Mountain and Afton) or American Racer 44 or harder (Big Diamond and Accord); Right-Rear – American Racer 38 or harder (Thunder Mountain and Afton) or American Racer 48 or harder (Big Diamond and Accord) – *Please note Bethel tire options will be released as event approaches*

Weights: 2,400 lbs. (Open – two-barrel carburetor) – 2,350 lbs. (unaltered GM Crate 602 – no gear or rev chip rule) – *All weights are post-race, with driver, track scale pounds*

Specific Bethel guidelines will be released as the event approaches.

If you are legal in the Open Sportsman division at Afton, Big Diamond, Grandview, New Egypt, Skyline or Thunder Mountain, you are legal to run this series.
